16 hours of HANDS-ON CE An Advanced Cardiac Life Support (ACLS) class

This is an ACLS course designed especially for dentists. This hands on course will include training that is custom made to equip dental practitioners with the skills necessary to respond appropriately to a cardiac emergency that could occur in the dental office.

"In this first time ACLS American Heart Association course, students will utilize their assessment skills, cardiac rhythm interpretation skills, and knowledge of the ACLS treatment algorithms to manage cardiac arrest, cardiovascular emergencies, and respiratory arrest.
